STEP 1: Review & Verify Qualifications

STEP 2: Complete Orientation (Choose One)

Orientation is for the youth and their parent/guardian (if under 18). Options:

STEP 3: Complete & Submit Application

STEP 4: Interview

20–40 minutes, confidential, one-on-one with admissions staff. In-person for Anchorage/Matsu/Fairbanks; telephonic/zoom options.

STEP 5: Conditional Acceptance

Usually determined immediately after the interview. All acceptances are **CONDITIONAL**. AMYA provides free flight transportation for accepted youth outside reasonable driving distance or off the road system.
