## **REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Within the Anchorage Bowl/Matsu area (or those within reasonable driving distance or choose to report to directly to Anchorage, youth in OCS/DJJ Custody)

2. Outside the Anchorage Bowl and Mat-Su area (not on road system/outside reasonable driving): Support staff will email you once they start making flights, which will not be until near the start of the cycle (in January). If you have not received any contact/flight itinerary by January 8, 2025 please contact AMYA at <a href="mailto:amyasupportservices@alaska.gov">amyasupportservices@alaska.gov</a> or 907-428-7306. Youth are picked up by AMYA staff outside the secure fight area, near the escalators. Flights will most likely be made for January 14, 2025, however this is dependent on flight schedule/weather.

If you have any issues or delays you will need to contact <u>amyasupportservices@alaska.gov</u> or 907-428-7306, if after hours, the TLC at 907-428-7325 or the Commandant at 907-428-7320. Admissions staff do not make flight arrangement.

AMYA only pays for the cost of the accepted youth. Parents/guardians who choose to escort their youth to Anchorage must do so at their own cost. Youth will still be transported directly from airport to campus.

\*\*\*YOUTH WHO ARE IN OCS/DJJ CUSTODY- TRAVEL/ESCORTED TRAVEL IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OCS/DJJ (this does not apply to supervision, custody only)\*\*\*

## **REPORTING APPEARANCE**

Candidates should report in appropriate athletic clothing/shoes. They will be exposed to physical activity prio
to being issued their PT clothes and uniforms.
Orthopedic/Supportive Items: If a youth requires specific insoles, knee braces (etc) or other item that is
medically necessary.
ABSOLUTELY NO HAIR EXTENSIONS/WEAVES- All must be removed prior to attending. Hair should be a natural
color.
ALL PIERCINGS MUST BE REMOVED- no clear piercings/spacers allowed
NO FAKE/ACRYLIC/GEL/POLISHED NAILS- clean unpolished natural finger nails only
NO EYELASH EXTENSIONS- these must be removed prior to attendance
NO CONTACTS, if vision correction is required you must wear prescription glasses

## **Medication Reminder:**

Medications are administered by the registered nurse or an authorized person for your cadet. If possible, medication prescriptions need to be supplied for the 5-month duration. Applicants are required to have at least a 30-day supply of needed medications and two months of refills (prescriptions). Medications to bring include any that your cadet is currently prescribed including asthma inhalers and EpiPens.
