**REPORTING/FLIGHT INSTRUCTIONS**

1. **Within the Anchorage Bowl/Matsu area** (or those within reasonable driving distance or choose to report to directly to Anchorage)

2. **Outside the Anchorage Bowl and Mat-Su area (not on road system/outside reasonable driving):**

No flights will be made until the medical packet is received. Support staff will email you once they start making flights. If you have not received any contact/flight itinerary by July 1, 2024 please contact AMYA at [amyasupportservices@alaska.gov](mailto:amyasupportservices@alaska.gov) or 907-428-7306. Youth are picked up outside baggage claim by AMYA staff and transported to campus. Flights will most likely be made for the July 16, 2024, however this is dependent on flight schedule/weather.

AMYA only pays for the cost of the accepted youth. Parents/guardians who choose to escort their youth to Anchorage must do so at their own cost. Youth will still be transported directly from airport to campus.

**REPORTING APPEARANCE**

- Candidates should report in appropriate athletic clothing/shoes. They will be exposed to physical activity prior to being issued their PT clothes and uniforms.
- Orthopedic/Supportive Items: If a youth requires specific insoles, knee braces (etc) or other item that is medically necessary.
- ABSOLUTELY NO HAIR EXTENSIONS/WEAVES**- All must be removed prior to attending. Hair should be a natural color.
- ALL PIERCINGS MUST BE REMOVED**- no clear piercings/spacers allowed
- NO FAKE/ACRYLIC/GEL/POLISHED NAILS**- clean unpolished natural finger nails only
- NO EYELASH EXTENSIONS**- these must be removed prior to attendance
- NO CONTACTS**, if vision correction is required you must wear prescription glasses

### Medication Reminder:

Medications are administered by the registered nurse or an authorized person for your cadet. If possible, medication prescriptions need to be supplied for the 5-month duration. Applicants are required to have at least a 30-day supply of needed medications and two months of refills (prescriptions). Medications to bring include any that your cadet is currently prescribed including asthma inhalers and EpiPens. **For questions regarding prescriptions for controlled medications, please contact 907-428-7353. ## PACKING LIST

### REQUIRED:

- Photo Identification Card** (Military Dependent, Federal (includes Tribal), or State ID)

### Recommended:

- 1st class Stamps/Forever Stamps:** 1-2 book(s)
- 2 pair of glasses and prescription:** if needed
- Females-Wireless Supportive Sports Bras-**white or gray only. 2-3

### IF NEEDED

- Orthopedic/Supportive Items:** If a youth requires specific insoles, knee or other brace, etc
- EpiPen or Rescue Inhaler, Prescription Only medications (no OTC unless prescribed by Dr with proof of RX)**

### OPTIONAL

- \*Religious Book/Reading Book/Journal**
- \*Personal Photos.** 2-3
- \*FACE MASKS:** 3 Washable/Reusable cloth face coverings.
- Watch - Nonmetal** band only - **LOW** value, **ALL BLACK ONLY** (no smart watches, Fitbit, chargeable etc)  
*\*please note you should pack these items in a reusable, re-sealable zipper storage bag (ie Ziploc). Candidates will be required to keep these items in their backpack at all times during acclimation, which means they may be exposed to precipitation while outside.*

**NO Luggage, Backpacks etc. Only youth who require flights can bring duffel bags.** All others should include packing list items in disposable bags (such as a plastic bag from grocery store, clear storage bag)

NO Cellular Phones, iPads/tablets, or other portable communication devices (*those flying in may have their cell phone for the flight, but will not have access to their cell for the duration of the time on campus*)

**DO NOT PACK ANYTHING NOT LISTED ABOVE, YOU WILL NOT HAVE ACCESS TO ANY OF YOUR ITEMS NOT ON THE PACKING LIST.**

## ALL OTHER ITEMS WILL BE ISSUED ON CAMPUS.

THIS INCLUDES UNIFORMS, SWEATS, BOOTS, COLD WEATHER GEAR, COATS, UNDERWEAR, SOCKS, FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS, SELF-CARE PRODUCTS (SOAP, DEODERANT, ETC)
