Some families prefer to complete the entire application packet at the same time (part 1 and 2 (Medical))- you can absolutely submit the entire application.

STEP 4: Interview- Interviews lasts 20-40 minutes are a ONE-ON-ONE CONFIDENTIAL interview between the applicant (youth) and admission staff.

- INTERVIEW- For Anchorage, Matsu, Fairbanks (contact your assigned admissions rep)
- Those outside Anchorage/Matsu/Fairbanks will have telephonic interviews.

STEP 5: Conditional Acceptance*

Conditional acceptance is usually determined immediately after the interview; however, some youth will be required to submit the medical packet prior to making that decision. All acceptances are CONDITIONAL!

STEP 6: Complete & Submit Medical Packet (2)*

In some instances, information in the medical packet may prevent the youth from attending. *Failure to submit the Medical Packet will result in youth being unable to attend.* AMYA will provide flight transportation at NO COST to the family for the accepted youth to Anchorage for those outside reasonable driving distance and/or off the road system (NO flights will be made until the Medical Packet has been received). Families may opt to report directly to Anchorage at their own expense. Once the cycle starts the primary contact will be the platoon leader or Team Leaders Center (TLC) 428-7325.
